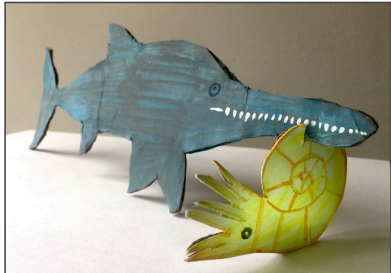


Make your own...

ICHTHYOSAUR AND AMMONITE

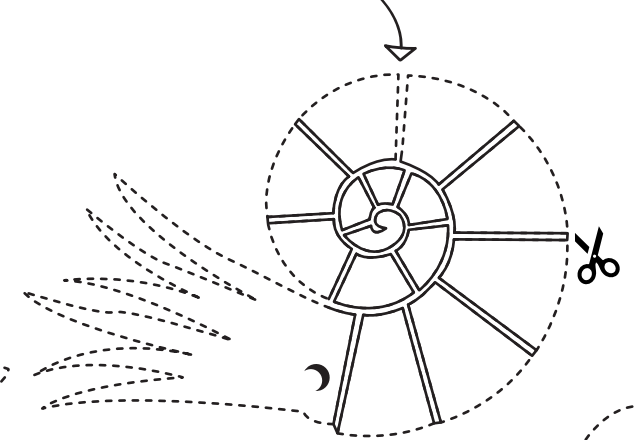
Ichthyosaurs were predatory. They had strong jaws and sharp teeth. They lived in the sea, so they ate any food they could find, catch, and kill. It was likely they ate shelled marine animals known as ammonites and other crunchy prey. They were very good at catching food. They had streamlined bodies capable of swimming up to 40 miles an hour.

We have created a template for you to make a cardboard model of your own ichthyosaur



catching an ammonite – the ammonite helps support the ichthyosaur! You could also draw straight onto cardboard. If you use the template, stick it onto thick cardboard and cut around it. It is a bit hard work if the cardboard is very thick but it will stand up better if thicker! Colour in your ichthyosaur and ammonite and then slot the jaw of the ichthyosaur onto the ammonite. If it is a bit wobbly you can bend the ichthyosaur so make it stand up better. Or use bluetak to keep it up!
